



## What we do:

Verity is Sonoma County's sole rape crisis, trauma, and healing center, dedicated to those who have been victimized by rape and sexual violence. We provide bilingual workshops on sexual violence, child abuse, diversity, healthy relationships, and challenging stereotypes. Our services include crisis intervention, referrals, and advocacy (both medical and legal); counseling and support groups; and direct services to individuals who are victims of human trafficking. Educational presentations in both Spanish and English create conversations and services that allow victims of sexual violence to be free from the chains of silence. No longer defined by the sexual assault they experienced, this newfound freedom assists individuals to move forward with their lives and to live the dream they have always wanted to live.

## Our start:

Verity was founded in 1974 as Women Against Rape (W.A.R.), a grassroots organization that provided a phone number women could call to speak to someone about the rape and sexual assault they experienced. Women gained insight, support, and advocacy to move forward with their lives.

In 2000, W.A.R. became U.A.S.A (United Against Sexual Assault) to reflect the expanded mission of serving women, men, children, and youth who had been victimized by rape and sexual violence.

In 2010, U.A.S.A formally became Verity reflecting our current bilingual crisis intervention, community prevention, and counseling programs offered to all who have been affected by sexual assault and violence in Sonoma County.
